

Re: SEMINAR PARKING CHANGES
Current Developments in Labor & Employment Law Seminar

Providing adequate parking for 30,000 students and more than 6,000 employees on the LSU campus is an expensive and difficult struggle. The Law Center has not been immune to the effects of that struggle. We are no longer able to reserve the lot next to the Law Center for seminar parking. You still have options, however, including:

A. Free parking available in the North Fraternity Lot, formerly X-60 Lot (#8 on this [map](#)), a 5-7 minute walk to/from the Law Center. You *must* pick up a free parking pass from the Visitor Center (corner of Highland Road and Dalrymple Drive) before parking in the lot. Be sure to mention the “Labor & Employment Law Seminar” to get a free pass for the lot.

B. Metered parking is available in the new Union Square Garage next to the Law Center (#9 on this [map](#)) at a reduced rate of \$6.00 per day (normally \$1.50 per hour) with a prepaid parking tag purchased through LSUcle. The prepaid tags will be handed out at the entrance to the garage. Visitors without a prepaid tag will be required to pay the full hourly price at one of the pay stations located on each level before leaving the garage on foot.

If you choose the garage for seminar parking, you may purchase a parking tag when you register for the seminar. There are two ways to register:

1. Register online at www.LSUcle.org. There is an optional checkbox for the parking fee.
2. Register by fax or mail. Use the [registration form](#) in the brochure you will soon receive by mail, or download a registration form from our website, www.LSUcle.org. There is an optional checkbox for the parking fee.

These changes were implemented last fall and were well received by our attendees. We trust you will also find the changes to be acceptable. We remain grateful for your patronage and hope you will continue to attend our seminars.
