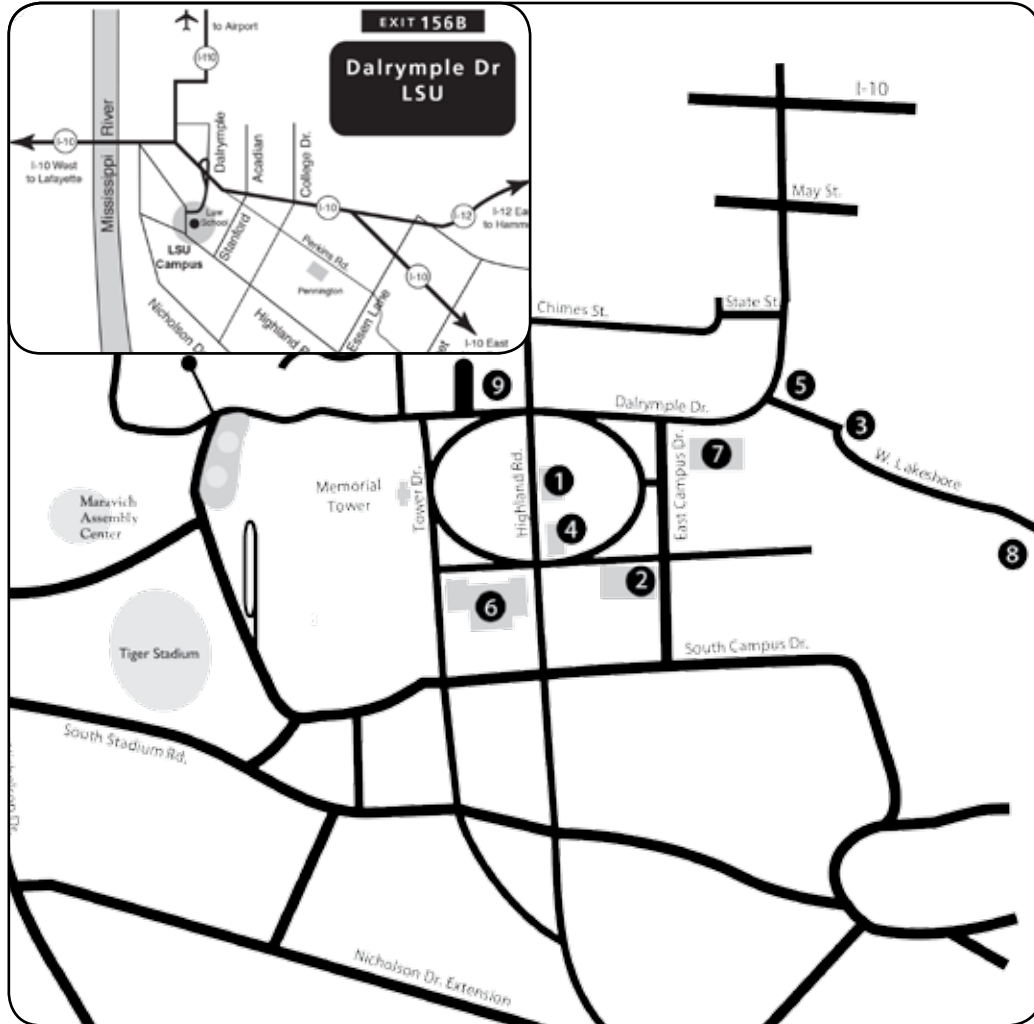

Parking

Limited, free parking is available in the North Fraternity Lot (3 on the map) located on W. Lakeshore. You must first obtain a temporary permit from the Visitor Center (9 on the map). Parking is also available in the Union Square Parking Garage (2 on the map) located next door to the Law Center. A special day rate for seminar parking of \$6/day is available.
