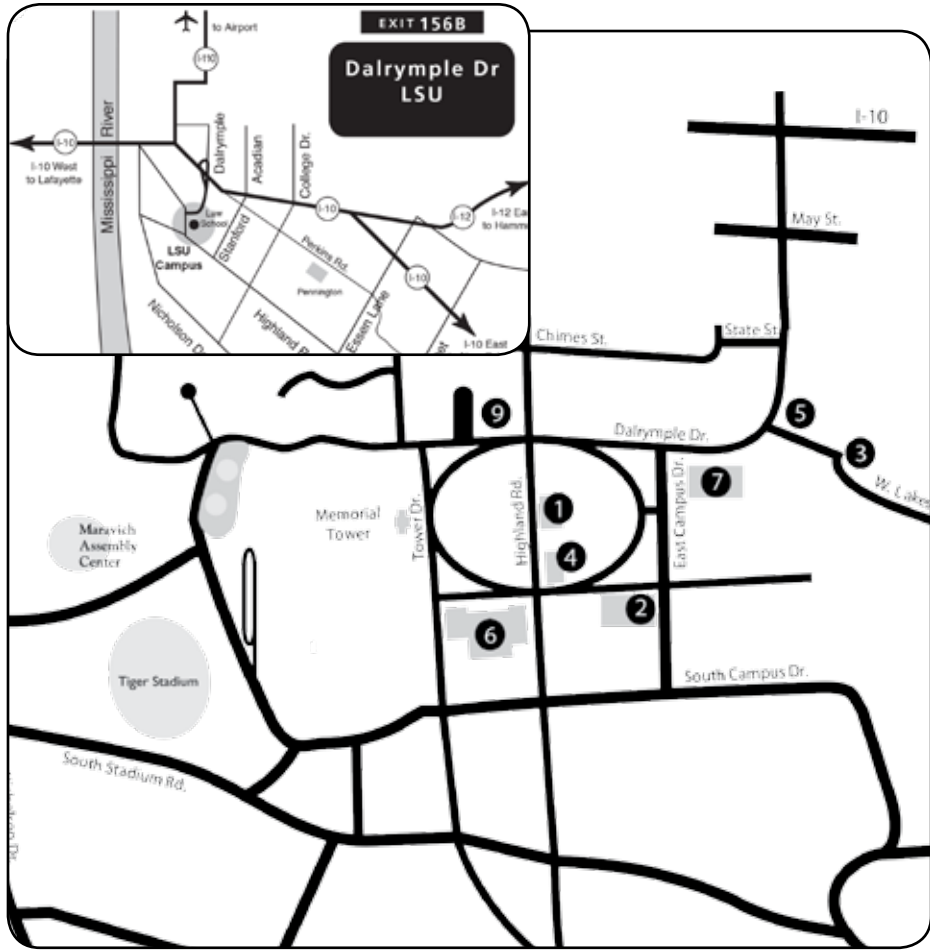

From I-10, take the Dalrymple exit. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp, and follow Dalrymple for 1/2 mile onto campus.

**Parking**

Weekday parking in the Law Center lot is no longer allowed. Limited free parking is available in the North Fraternity Lot (#3 on map) located on W. Lakeshore. However, you must first obtain a temporary permit from the Visitor Center (#9 on map). Metered parking is available in the Union Square Parking Garage (#2 on map) for \$6/day if you purchase a parking tag, in advance, from LSUcle.
