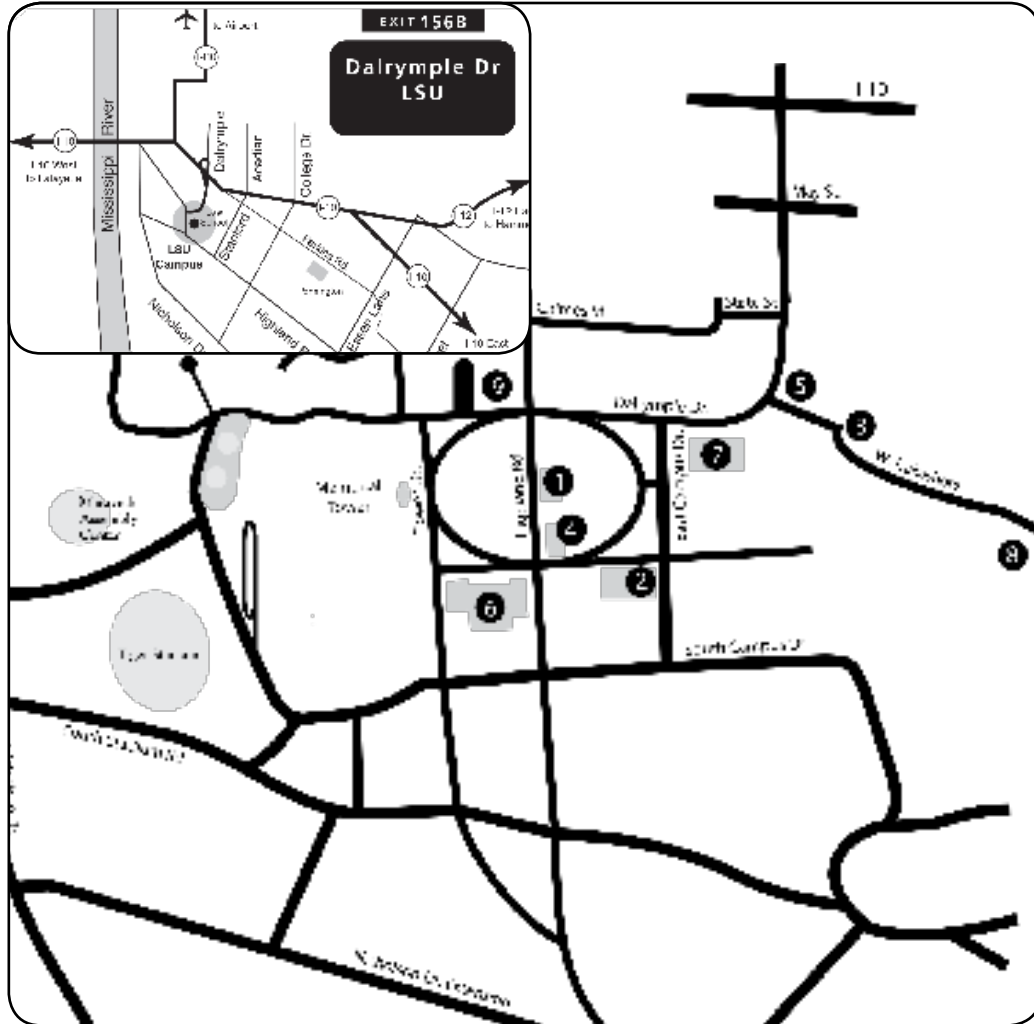

Getting to the LSU Campus

From I-10, take the Dalrymple exit. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp, and follow Dalrymple for 1/2 mile onto campus.

Parking
