From I-10 West, take College Drive Exit, turn left onto College Drive, turn left at second traffic light (Constitution Ave.) near Chili's Restaurant. Continue on Constitution Ave. for 1/4 mile.

From I-10 East, take College Drive Exit. In short order, the exit lane will divide. Veer right. Just before you get to College Drive, the lane splits again (right lane for College Drive, left lane for Constitution Ave). Get into the left lane and go straight at the traffic light, across College and onto Constitution Ave. You will see Chili's Restaurant straight ahead. Continue on Constitution Ave. for 1/4 mile.
